F.1 LISTING OF CLAUSES INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE

NOTICE: The following solicitation provisions and/or contract clauses pertinent to this section are hereby incorporated by reference:

F.2 FLIGHT ITEM (JSC 52.247-95) (SEPT 1989)

Block 16 of each Department of Defense Form 250 prepared for hardware or equipment to be shipped under this contract must be annotated as follows in 1/4-inch letters or larger by hand printing or rubber stamp:

“THIS IS A FLIGHT ITEM” OR “THIS IS MISSION ESSENTIAL GROUND SUPPORT EQUIPMENT,” as applicable.

F.3 PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The period of performance for the contract shall begin upon the effective date of the contract and shall end on May 31, 2011. Task Orders placed prior to the expiration date of this contract shall remain in full force and effect until deliveries have been completed and payment has been made.

F.4 DELIVERY OF AIRCRAFT

Upon delivery of an aircraft to the Contractor's facility, the contractor shall modify, overhaul and/or repair and prepare the aircraft for return to the Government in accordance with the delivery/performance schedule contained in the applicable task order.

In the event of premature failure or unscheduled repair that requires replacement of any major accessory/line replacement unit, the Contractor shall deliver such item to NASA at the aircraft location.

SECTION F

DELIVERIES OR PERFORMANCE

F.5 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT

The Government may require the contractor to continue to perform services under this contract. The Contracting Officer may exercise this option by issuance of a unilateral contract modification 30 days or more before the end of the period of performance set forth in clause F.3, provided the Government gives the contractor a preliminary notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension. The total duration of this contract including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed five (5) years. Should an option be exercised, the resultant contract will include all terms and conditions of the basic contract as it exists immediately prior to the exercise of the option, except for the following changes:

OPTION 1

The unit prices for supplies and services that may be ordered and the Contractor may be obligated to furnish for Option 1 are set forth in the pricing table located in Section B.3.4 of the contract.

F.3 entitled "Period of Performance" shall be modified to extend the ending date of the contract to May 31, 2012.

OPTION 2

The unit prices for supplies and services that may be ordered and the Contractor may be obligated to furnish for Option 2 are set forth in the pricing table located in Section B.3.5 of the contract.

F.3 entitled "Period of Performance" shall be modified to extend the ending date of the contract to May 31, 2013.
