Dear Mr. Stangler:

This report provides you with the results of our audit entitled *Missouri's Adoption and Foster Care Analysis and Reporting System*, otherwise known as AFCARS. The purpose of our review was to assess Missouri's system for selecting, collecting, recording, and verifying performance data submitted to the Administration for Children and Families (ACF). Specifically, we reviewed Missouri's AFCARS data collection procedures and verified the data elements reported to ACF for the first six months of Federal Fiscal Year (FY) 1999.

We found Missouri (State) reported foster care data to ACF that was inaccurate and incomplete. We are recommending the State implement and/or strengthen procedures to ensure: 1) foster care data at the county offices is being entered accurately; 2) computer programs properly download information from the State system to the AFCARS format; and 3) downloaded foster care data is evaluated for accuracy and completeness.

The State was in general agreement with our findings and recommendations. A copy of the State's response to our draft report is provided in its entirety as Appendix B.

INTRODUCTION

BACKGROUND

In 1993, Congress passed the Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA) which shifted focus from activities to the results of those activities. The GPRA mandated that Federal agencies establish strategic planning and prepare annual performance plans, beginning with a plan for FY 1999.

The purpose of the performance plan is to clearly inform Congress and the public of the agency's annual performance goals, the measures used to assess performance, the strategies required to achieve performance, and the procedures used to verify and validate performance information. The annual performance plan establishes the connection between long term goals outlined in the

strategic plan and the day to day activities of management and staff, and sets out measurable goals that define what will be accomplished during the fiscal year.

I

The ACF Annual Performance Plan covers all of the programs administered by ACF for the economic and social well being of children, youth, and families. For a number of major programs, ACF is largely dependent upon State administered systems for the collection of performance data. The AFCARS reporting system is designed to collect State performance data specifically related to adoption and title IV-B/IV-E foster care. Federal requirements for AFCARS are set forth at 45 Code of Federal Regulations 1355.40.

There were 66 foster care and 37 adoption data elements in AFCARS. The data elements for foster care consisted of a child's general and demographic information, placement settings, circumstances associated with removal, case plan goals, caretaker information, termination of rights, foster parent data, discharge data, and sources of Federal financial funding. The data elements for adoption consisted of a child's general and demographic information, special needs status, birth parents, court actions, adoptive parent data, placement information, and sources of Federal financial funding.

The State agencies were required to begin collecting the AFCARS data on October 1, 1994 and submit it semi-annually to ACF. This data was then compiled to compare actual performance with performance goals set out in the annual performance plan.

At the State, the Department of Social Services is responsible for collecting and recording the AFCARS data. The State submitted data to ACF in the AFCARS format for the first time in FY 1998.

SCOPE OF REVIEW

We conducted our review in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards, except that our review of internal controls was limited to obtaining an understanding of the State's AFCARS data collection procedures and verifying data elements. We did not review the overall internal control structure of the State.

The objective of our review was to assess the Missouri system for selecting, collecting, recording, and verifying performance data submitted to ACF through AFCARS. Specifically, we reviewed and verified that the data elements for the first six months of FY 1999 were accurate and reliable. We discussed Federal and State policies and procedures with State and Regional ACF personnel, reviewed background information on AFCARS and Federal regulations related to the collection and reporting of adoption and foster care data. Our review included visits to selected county offices located throughout the State. At these offices, we reviewed case files of children involved in the adoption and foster care programs to become familiar with specific documents included in the files. We also interviewed personnel in order to obtain an understanding of the procedures for collecting and reporting the AFCARS data at the county office level.

To determine the validity of the data received by ACF, we reconciled the State and ACF versions of Missouri's AFCARS data files for the period October 1, 1998 through March 31, 1999. Using the State's AFCARS data files, we then verified adoption and foster care computer data to both the individual case files and the Missouri computer system for Cole county.

We performed our work during the period April through July 1999 at the Regional ACF office in Kansas City, Missouri, State offices in Jefferson City, Missouri, and county offices in Pettis, Livingston, Pulaski, Jefferson, St. Louis City, St. Louis, and Cole counties.

FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

During our review of the data collected and recorded by the county office, we found 92 of the 198 foster care cases contained errors. A detailed listing of the cases with errors is shown in Appendix A. The 92 cases had a total of 124 errors in the following categories:

Although the county made clerical errors, the preponderance of the errors related to the downloading of data, which was a State-wide problem. The State's computer system contained accurate data. However, when the program designed to create AFCARS data was applied to the State computer system, errors occurred. Consequently, we believe there are flaws in the design of the State's AFCARS computer program.

These errors could have caused information on foster care children in the ACF Performance Plan to be inaccurate, incomplete, and therefore, unreliable. However, to date, the Missouri AFCARS data has not been used in the statistics for the ACF Performance Plan. The State submitted data for FYs 1998 and 1999. The ACF did not use those years in developing baseline data for the years 1999 or 2000 ACF Performance Plans. Page 4 - Mr. Gary J. Stangler

We are recommending the State implement and/or strengthen procedures to ensure:

- foster care data at the county offices is being entered accurately;
- computer programs properly download information from the State system to the AFCARS format; and
- downloaded foster care data is evaluated for accuracy and completeness.

Auditee Comments

The State was in general agreement with our findings and recommendations (See Appendix B). State officials indicated that they: had identified and corrected the problem associated with misreporting of disability conditions; were redesigning tracking forms to reduce clerical errors during data entry; and were continuing to investigate the other reporting errors. These officials said that they were committed to reporting accurate data for the children they serve.

We are anticipating that we will soon be able to redesign our Alternative Care Tracking form to reduce clerical errors associated with the entry of this data into our system. We will need additional time to investigate the remainder of the problems and as such have not yet formulated plans for rectifying them.

We appreciate the opportunity to respond to your audit findings and are committed to enhancing our system and reporting only the most accurate data for the children we serve.
