
Conservation On the Ground -

Children Learn the Value of Good Nutrition





With grants from Heifer International and the Cawaco RC&D Council in Birmingham, AL, a registered dietitian has been contracted to go into Birmingham City Schools to teach children about nutrition and how it affects their health. The positive impact of the program was featured on a November 7, 2002, televised segment called "What's Right with Our Schools." The nutrition program grew out of an RC&D project that became the BUGS (Birmingham Urban Garden Society)

one garden in 1996, the program has grown to 15 community

gardens, 23 school gardens, 18 vermiculture (worm) indoor garden bins, one pepper bottling operation, and three harvest festivals. The nutrition lessons were a natural extension of the community gardens and school
