The D.C. Superior Court and the D.C. Child and Family Services Agency will co-host the 22nd Annual Adoption Day in Court on Saturday, November 15, 2008. The ceremony is designed to celebrate the joy of adoption and encourage area residents to consider adopting or fostering a child. **Nearly 200 children in D.C. are in foster care, awaiting adoption.**

Nearly 20 actual adoptions will be finalized at this year's ceremony and adoption decrees will be signed before the audience, as the children and their new families come forward. Each child will be introduced to the audience by emcee Barbara Harrison, local news anchor.
