

SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 02-04

WHEREAS, The District of Columbia Family Court Act of 2001 (“the Act”) reorganizes the manner in which cases of children and families are handled in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the Act will require substantial effort by the Court, and coordination and consultation with all city agencies, organizations and members of the Bar affected by its provisions; and

WHEREAS, a committee of representatives of the relevant entities is necessary to oversee implementation;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is by the Court,

ORDERED, there is hereby created the Family Court Implementation Committee (“the Committee”), whose purpose will be to oversee the implementation of The District of Columbia Family Court Act of 2001; and it is further

ORDERED, the Committee shall be co-chaired by the Presiding and Deputy Presiding Judges of the Family Court, a division of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia. The Committee shall be comprised of one representative from each of the following organizations, to be

designated from time to time by the head of said organization: the District of Columbia Bar, Office of the Corporation Counsel, the Child and Family Services Agency, the Youth Services Administration, the Public Defender Service, the Metropolitan Police Department, the District of Columbia Public Schools; representatives from the Family Division Trial Lawyers Association and the D.C. Bar as necessary to represent the respective CCAN, Juvenile, Domestic Relations, and Mental Health bars; and the following judicial officers and court staff:
