

**SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA**

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 05-13**

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that the District of Columbia will in the near future file an eminent domain action related to a baseball stadium; and,

**WHEREAS**, in consequence of such action funds will be placed in the registry of the Superior Court pursuant to D.C. Code § 16-1314 and SCR-Civ. 71-A(j); and,

**WHEREAS**, the District of Columbia has specifically requested that this order be issued;

**WHEREAS**, a court order is needed (pursuant to Administrative Order No. 94-26) to place those funds in an interest-bearing account and a delay will cause substantial loss to the District of Columbia; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby,

**ORDERED** that such funds shall be placed in a collateralized interest-bearing account subject to reasonable deductions therefrom for bank fees, and it is

**FURTHER ORDERED** that this order is subject to modification by the trial judge to whom the case is assigned.
