Move westward and find trout in the high country of New Mexico and an abundance of warm water species in the lowland refuges of western Arizona along the mighty Colorado River.

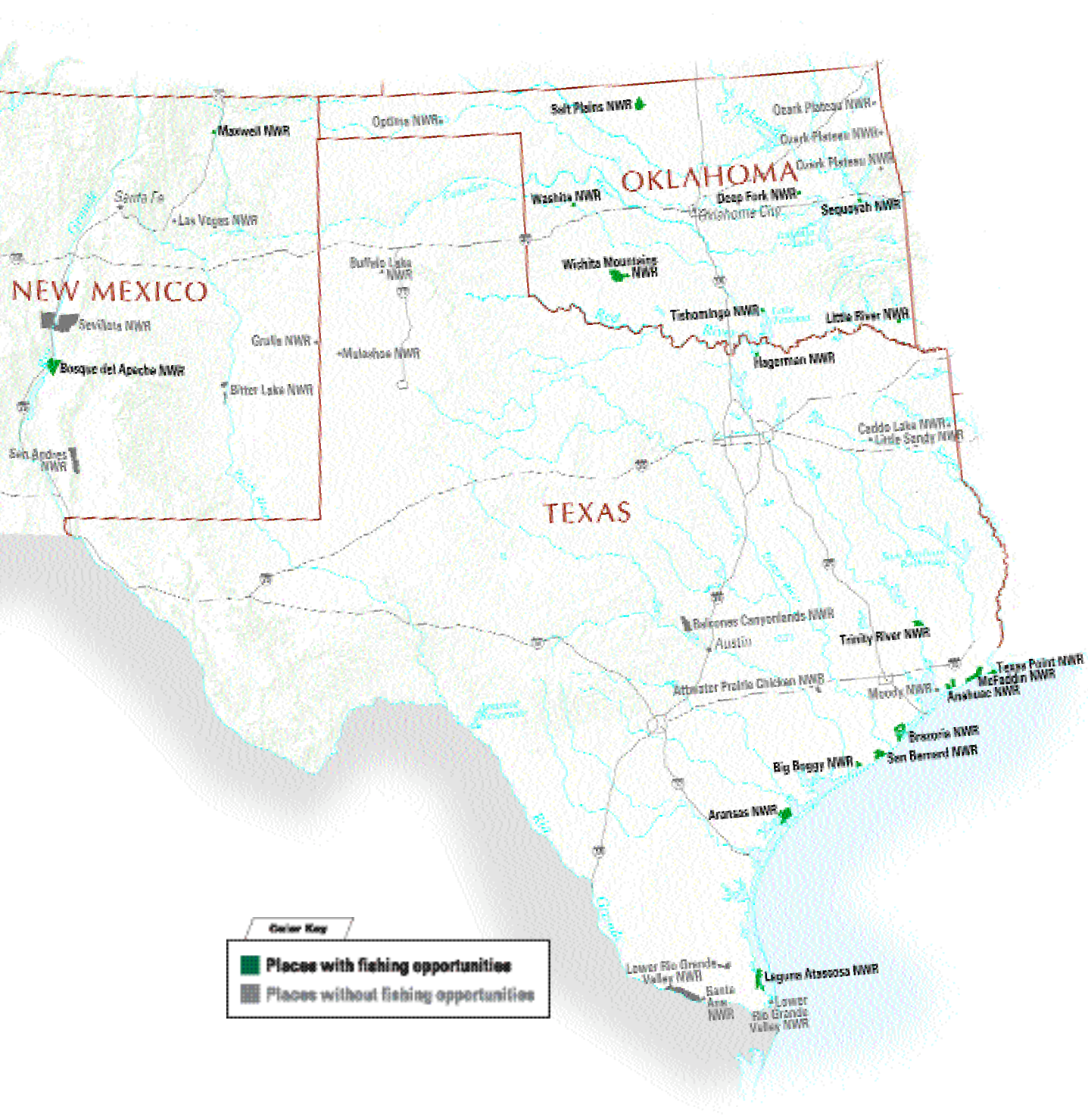
