ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

The Northern District of New York's Local Rules of Practice include a provision requiring all permanent, active members of the Northern District Bar to pay a \$30.00 biennial registration fee. (See Local Rule 83.1(a)(5)) Notices were sent to you via electronic mail, at the address of record with the Court, on **May 1, 2007 and July 31, 2007** regarding the biennial registration fee. The Court's records indicate that to date, you have not complied.

NOW, it is hereby

ORDERED, that you pay the \$30.00 biennial registration fee on or before **November 30, 2007**.

Failure to comply with this order will result in the removal of your name from the bar of the Northern District of New York without further action of the Court.
