ALLEGED VIOLATIONS:

In or around and between July, 2004 and August, 2004, Wein-Bauer Distributing, Inc. violated the conditions of its basic permit by furnishing or giving money, free goods, and/or other things of value directly to a retail liquor dealer, Sam's Wines & Liquors, Inc. ("Sam's"), and /or indirectly to such retailer through Skyline Marketing, Inc. ("Skyline"), a merchandising/promotional service company. Wein-Bauer Distributing, Inc. also paid or credited Sam's, directly and/or indirectly through Skyline, for advertising, display or distribution service and/or purchased or rented display, shelf, storage or warehouse space directly from Sam's and/or indirectly from Sam's through Skyline. These acts violate 27 U.S.C. 205(b)(2), 205(b)(3) and/or(b)(4) and 27 C.F.R. 6.41 and /or 6.51.

BUSINESS IN WHICH ENGAGED:

The proponent is engaged in business as a wholesaler of wine, distilled spirits, and/or malt beverages.

DATE OR PERIOD AND LOCATION OF ALLEGED VIOLATIONS:

On or about and between July, 2004 and August, 2004, at 10600 Seymour Avenue; Franklin Park, IL 60131.

AMOUNT AND TERMS OF OFFER:

The proponent has submitted an offer of \$3,000.00, which will be paid in 4 installment payments, in compromise of the above violations incurred under the Federal Alcohol Administration Act.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Director, National Revenue Center recommends acceptance of the offer. In view of potential litigation hazards, acceptance of this Offer in Compromise, as submitted, is warranted.
