**Ellen Fox, M.D.**, is a board certified internist and Director of the National Center for Ethics in Health Care of the Veterans Health Administration. In this capacity, she is responsible for promoting ethical health care practices throughout the nation's largest health care system. Previously she served as Director of End-of-Life Care for the Institute for Ethics of the American Medical Association, and Director of the Education for Physicians on End-of-Life Care (EPEC) Project (1997-99). She also served as Director of the Program in Clinical Ethics at the University of Illinois at Chicago Medical School (1994-97) and as a core faculty member at the MacLean Center for Clinical Medical Ethics at the University of Chicago (1992-94). Originally from Arlington, Virginia, Dr. Fox graduated *summa cum laude* from Yale College and earned her MD from Harvard Medical School. She received her residency training at Yale, where she also served as Chief Resident. At the University of Chicago, she completed a Fellowship in Medical Ethics.
