## **Size and Weight Standards for Project Documents**

OSHPD requires a size and weight limit for plans/drawings that are submitted to OSHPD for project review. Many large hospital construction projects are submitted on oversized plans and in heavy bundles which pose problems for our staff and require special handling. Consequently, this results in delays to project intake and project review. In an effort to avoid delays associated with oversized and overweight sets of plans, the Office requires that project drawing size should not exceed 36" X 48" and bundles of drawings should not exceed 40 pounds each.

OSHPD requires design professionals to follow these standards and appreciates any effort made to assist in this matter. Any questions regarding project document size and weight may be directed to the Office's Regional Supervisors or Regional Compliance Officers.
