Gap-filling Instructions

Gap-filling

- Carriers should examine
 - charges for the test and routine discounts to charges
 - resources required to perform the test
 - payment amounts determined by other payers
 - charges, payment amounts, and resources required for other tests that may be comparable or otherwise relevant
- Carriers may consider other sources including:
 - clinical studies and information provided by clinicians practicing in the area, manufacturers, or other interested parties
