U.S. export sales were down in November 2000. Upland cotton sales for delivery in MY 2000/2001 during Oct 27 - Nov 30 (5 weeks) registered net sales of 470,900 running bales, a weekly average of 94,180 bales. In MY 1999/2000 upland sales during Nov 4 - Dec 2, registered net sales of 949,800 running bales, a weekly average of 188,960 bales. The weekly upland export average through Nov 30 for MY 2000/2001 was 78,000 running bales against MY 1999/2000's weekly export average of 58,000 running bales. Accumulated exports through Nov 30 for MY 2000/2001 were 1.4 million running bales, compared with 1.05 million bales last year. Total upland outstanding sales for MY 2000/2001 were 2.597 million running bales, compared with 3.397 million bales the same time a year ago. Upland commitments to date were 4.0 million running bales, compared with 4.4 million bales last year. Pima export sales during Oct 27 - Nov 30 for delivery during MY 2000/2001 totaled 26,100 running bales and total net sales were 24,500 running bales. Pima accumulated exports through Nov 30 for MY 2000/2001 totaled 116,800 running bales, compared with 62,900 running bales the same time a year ago. Total Pima commitments amounted to 369,000 running bales.
