IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint arising from his attempt to appeal an adverse decision in the trial court. The specific allegations in the judicial misconduct complaint are that the complained about judge did not give reasons in denying complainant's request to appeal without paying a fee and the orders did not have the judge's signature. A judge is not required to give reasons for every action taken and there is no requirement that a judge sign all court decisions. This complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(i and ii) and Rule 11(c)(1)(A and B) of the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.
