8. CHARGE
VIOLATIONS:
 During the period September 1, 2001 through August 15, 2004, the proponent allegedly violated Title 26, United States Code, Section 5061(e) and Title 27, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 25.165, by failing to pay excise taxes by Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT). As a result, the proponent incurred the failure to deposit penalty imposed by Title 26, United States Code, Section 6656.

BUSINESS IN WHICH ENGAGED:
 The proponent is a duly qualified brewery.

DATE OR PERIOD and LOCATION OF VIOLATION:
 September 1, 2001 through August 15, 2004 at the proponent's premises at 603 East Brewery Street, Shiner, Texas 77984.

AMOUNT AND TERMS OF OFFER:
 The proponent has submitted an offer of \$50,000.00 in compromise of the above violations.

RECOMMENDATION OF DIRECTOR, NATIONAL REVENUE CENTER:
 The Director, National Revenue Center, recommends acceptance of \$50,000.00 as this amount is both commensurate with the nature of the violations, and is sufficient to deter recurrence. The proprietor has been cooperative, and has taken action to correct the situation. In view of future compliance, acceptance of this Offer in Compromise as submitted is warranted.

I have considered the proposition to compromise the liability as charged herein, and, for the reasons embodied in the above abstract and statement, am of the opinion that it will be for the best interest of the United States to ACCEPT REJECT the terms proposed.
