The services of the National Mediation Board (NMB or Board) were invoked by the International Brotherhood of Teamsters (IBT) on February 11, 2005, to investigate and determine who may represent for the purposes of the Railway Labor Act (RLA), as provided by Section 2, Ninth, thereof, personnel described as "Mechanics and Related Employees," employees of World Airways, Inc.

At the time this application was received, these employees were unrepresented.

The Board assigned Investigator Norman L. Graber to investigate.

Subsequently, Donald R. Treichler, Director Airline Division, IBT filed a letter with the NMB which stated, "the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Airline Division, is withdrawing its application in the above case."

On the basis of this letter of withdrawal referred to above, the Board hereby dismisses the application and closed its file subject to Part 1206.4(b) of the NMB's Rules.
