Issuance of Notice of Violation to TXI/Riverside Cement Company

Based on our review of reports provided by TXI/Riverside Cement Company, located at 1500 Rubidoux Blvd., Riverside, we have determined that TXI/Riverside Cement Company has operated in violations of AQMD RECLAIM (Regulation XX), Title V (Regulation XXX) and Permits (Regulation II). Therefore, yesterday our staff issued the following Notice of Violation to TXI/Riverside Cement Company:

Notice of Violation # P47996 for violating the following rules on multiple days beginning in 2005:

◆ 2004(b)(1)

Late submittal of quarterly certified emission reports beyond the end of the reconciliation period (30 days) of each quarter.

♦ 2004(b)(4)

Late submittal of Annual Permit Emission Program (APEP) Report beyond 60 days after the end of a compliance year

♦ 2011(c)(4)(C)(ii)

Failure to calculate and report SOx emissions based on permitted super-compliant concentration limit.

\bullet 2004(b)(2) and 2004(d)(4)

Filing inaccurate emissions by not calculating SOx emissions as required by Regulation XX and the Facility Permit

\bullet 2012(c)(2)(A)

Failure to have an operating direct monitoring device to continuously monitor NOx emissions.

◆ 2009.1(f)(3)

Exceeding NOx emission limit imposed under an approved compliance plan.

♦ 2004(f)(1), 203(b) and 3002 (c)(1)

Exceeding NOx emission limit imposed under Facility Permit and Title V Permit.

These violations were detected by Engineering and Compliance staff during RECLAIM and Title V audit of reports submitted by TXI/Riverside Cement Company.

My staff is continuing to evaluate and review additional information and records to determine whether TXI/Riverside Cement is operating in compliance with all applicable air quality rules and regulations. Please let me know if you have any questions or need additional information. Thanks.
