



# Geothermal Energy System Credit

## Instructions

The geothermal energy system credit is allowed only to Montana residents. The total allowable credit is \$1,000. The credit is limited to \$250 a year for a four year period beginning with the year the initial costs of installation begin. Unused portions of the \$250 yearly credit cannot be carried over to a succeeding year.

“Geothermal energy system” means a system that transfers energy either from the ground, by way of a closed loop or from ground water, by way of an open loop for the purpose of heating or cooling a residential building. A qualifying system shall transfer energy either from the ground, ground water or surface water. It should also have a heat pump utilizing a refrigerant cycle. If the system does not contain a heat pump, utilizing a refrigerant cycle, the “energy conservation purpose” of the system must be explained.
