

2008 Fire Safety Workshop for Federal Agencies 1 – 5 PM on April 2, 2008

Colleagues at Federal Agencies are invited to attend a half-day Fire Safety Workshop, which is being planned to explore mutual fire safety research interests among government agencies. While many federal agencies conduct and support fire safety research, many of us know little about each other's work.

The objective of the meeting is to identify overlapping fire safety interests among government agencies and to organize collaborative research activities. No formal presentations are planned. An attempt will be made to prioritize problems common to all federal agencies and explore opportunities for collaboration. The focus this year will be to identify collaborative projects and/or possibly government-wide projects or initiatives that benefit a fire safety agenda across federal agencies. More than twenty federal agencies are being invited to participate.
