

AHIC – American Health Information Community	<ul> <li>7 Meetings completed in FY 06; 450 person hours; supported by approximately 45 work group meetings throughout the year.</li> <li>First annual adoption survey report published</li> <li>Clinical Decision Support Roadmap developed</li> <li>New regulations creating exceptions and safe harbors to federal fraud and abuse laws to help physicians obtain automated systems</li> <li>Executive Order To Help Increase The Transparency of America's Health Care System- Empowering Americans To Find Better Value And Better Care</li> </ul>
HITSP – Health IT Standards Panel	<ul> <li>Delivered 1st set of Interoperability Standards in October 2006 for First 3 Use Cases. Includes 30 standards and over 800 pages of interoperability guidelines.</li> <li>Use Case Development</li> <li>Establishing a process for identifying, adopting, &amp; stimulating standards</li> </ul>
CCHIT- Certification Commission for Health IT	■Early Fall, 2006 first set of certified ambulatory EHRS released ■Expanded to 35 Electronic Health Record systems certified to date

NHIN – Nationwide Health Information Network Prototypes	<ul> <li>Progress toward National Health Information Network (NHIN) architecture</li> <li>Hosted two NHIN conferences</li> <li>1st Forum – Identified and catalogued functional requirements to frame the development of the NHIN</li> <li>2nd Forum - Advanced discussions and developed clarity on architecture issues associated with secure exchange; health information networking; desired architecture characteristics and key next steps to advance the NHIN</li> </ul>
Privacy and Security Solutions	■Health Information Security and Privacy Collaboration (HISPC) formed as a result of Privacy and Solutions contract
	■34 states and territories identified variations in privacy and security solutions
State Alliance for e-Health	■State Alliance for e-Health Contract awarded ■Established Steering Committee and identified 3 Task Forces ■Submitted interim assessment of variations
