SUBJECT: MID-CYCLE PERFORMANCE REVIEW AND INSPECTION PLAN - CALVERT CLIFFS

Dear Mr. Cruse:

On November 6, 2000, the NRC staff completed its Mid-Cycle plant performance assessment of Calvert Cliffs. The Mid-Cycle Review for Calvert Cliffs involved the participation of the responsible technical divisions in Region I evaluating performance indicators (PIs) and inspection results for the period of April 2, 2000 through September 30, 2000. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility so that you will have an opportunity to prepare for these inspections and to inform us of any planned inspections which may conflict with your plant activities.

Plant performance for the most recent quarter was within the Regulatory Response column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on the Unit 1 white performance indicator for scrams with a loss of normal heat removal (LONHR) in the initiating events cornerstone. Based upon our review of your staff's actions to address this white performance indicator (reference Supplemental Inspection Report 05000317/2000-010, dated November 7, 2000), re-inspection of this area is planned coincident with the Problem Identification and Resolution team inspection scheduled for May 2001. We noted during our supplemental inspection that your staff had not evaluated recent LONHR events in sufficient detail to have developed and implemented corrective actions with a reasonable assurance of preventing future scrams with a LONHR. Scrams with a LONHR are risk significant because of the consequential reliance on back-up safety related systems to perform the reactor residual heat removal function.

Enclosure 1 details the scheduled inspections that will occur through September 30, 2001. The inspection plan is provided to minimize the resource impact on your staff and to allow for scheduling conflicts and personnel availability to be resolved in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The last six months of the inspection plans are tentative and may be revised at the end-of-cycle review meeting.
