SUBJECT: MID-CYCLE PERFORMANCE REVIEW AND INSPECTION PLAN -
CRYSTAL RIVER 3

Dear Mr. Cowan:

On November 7, 2000, the NRC staff completed its mid-cycle plant performance assessment of the Crystal River 3 Nuclear Plant. The mid-cycle review for Crystal River 3 involved the participation of all technical divisions in evaluating performance indicators (PIs) for the most recent quarter and inspection results for the period of April 2, 2000 through September 30, 2000. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility so that you will have an opportunity to prepare for these inspections and to inform us of any planned inspections which may conflict with your plant activities.

Plant performance for the most recent quarter was in the Regulatory Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on one white PI (Reactor Coolant System Leakage) in the barrier integrity cornerstone. A white PI is indicative of licensee performance that may result in increased NRC oversight. The leakage exceeded the white PI threshold in August, 2000. A supplemental inspection was completed by the NRC on November 1, 2000, to assess your staff's activities associated with the increased leakage. Your staff replaced the leaking safety valve and conducted leak sealant repairs on the decay heat valve. These actions significantly reduced the reactor coolant system leakage rate and returned the performance indicator to the green performance level. Therefore, we plan to conduct only baseline inspections at your facility through September 30, 2001.

The enclosed inspection plan details the scheduled inspections through September 30, 2001. The plan is provided to minimize the resource impact on your staff and to allow for scheduling conflicts and personnel availability to be resolved in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The last six months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the end-of-cycle review meeting.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public

Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/NRC/ADAMS/index.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).
