SUBJECT: ANNUAL ASSESSMENT LETTER - DIABLO CANYON

(REPORT 50-275, 323/01-01)

Dear Mr. Rueger:

On May 8, 2001, NRC staff completed its end-of-cycle plant performance assessment of Diablo Canyon. The end-of-cycle review for Diablo Canyon involved the participation of all technical divisions in evaluating performance indicators (PIs) for the most recent quarter and inspection results for the period April 2, 2000, to March 31, 2001. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility so that you will have an opportunity to prepare for these inspections and to inform us of any planned inspections that may conflict with your plant activities.

Overall, Diablo Canyon operated in a manner that preserved public health and safety and fully met all cornerstone objectives. Plant performance for the most recent quarter was within the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all PIs indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green).

While plant performance for the most recent quarter is within the licensee response column of the Action Matrix, there was a low to moderate safety significant performance indicator during the first three quarters of the assessment cycle. The Scram with Loss of Normal Heat Removal for Unit 2 was White at the initiation of the Revised Oversight Program (second quarter 2000). This performance indicator returned to the licensee response band (Green) by the third quarter 2000. Supplemental Inspection 50-323/00-13, performed in August 2000, found the corrective actions appropriate for this performance indicator. Therefore, we plan to conduct only baseline inspections at your facility through May 31, 2002. Because of the energy situation in California and your financial situation, the resident inspector inspection periods will continue to be 6 weeks in length through December 2001. The routine reviews by the resident inspectors, increased visits by Region IV managers, and biweekly calls with your staff will also continue. These actions will be documented in the inspection reports.

The enclosure details the scheduled inspections that will occur through May 31, 2002. The inspection plan is provided to minimize the resource impact on your staff and to allow for

scheduling conflicts and personnel availability to be resolved in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature.

For your information, the NRC is in the process of aligning the inspection and assessment cycle with the calender year. In order to transition to a calender year cycle (January 1 through December 31), the next inspection and assessment cycle will consist of only three quarters (i.e., the second, third, and fourth calendar quarters of CY 2001). As a result, a quarterly review will be conducted for the third calendar quarter (July 1 through September 30) in lieu of a midcycle review. The impact on the inspection plan, which is included as an enclosure, is minimal. Activities planned for the transition cycle represent only 60-80 percent of those activities that would be accomplished during a typical 12-month inspection and assessment cycle.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
