DRESDEN NUCLEAR POWER STATION

Dear Mr. Crane:

On August 14, 2007, the NRC staff completed its performance review of the Dresden Nuclear Power Station for the first half of the calendar year 2007 assessment cycle. Our technical staff reviewed performance indicators (PIs) for the most recent quarter and inspection results over the previous 12 months. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility.

This performance review and enclosed inspection plan do not include security information. A separate letter designated and marked as "Official Use Only - Security Information" will include the security cornerstone review and resultant inspection plan.

Dresden Unit 2 remains within the Regulatory Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix based on one White PI having crossed the threshold from Green to White for the Scrams With Loss of Normal Heat Removal performance indicator. A supplemental inspection using inspection procedure 95001, "Inspection for One or Two White Inputs in a Strategic Performance Area," was performed in February 2007 and although no findings were identified, a subsequent scram on May 4, 2007, kept the PI beyond the White threshold. No additional supplemental inspections are planned for this PI.

Dresden Unit 3 plant performance for the most recent quarter, as well as for the first three quarters of the assessment cycle, was within the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all PIs indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green). Therefore, we plan to conduct Reactor Oversight Program baseline inspections of Unit 3.

The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections, less those related to security, scheduled through December 31, 2008. The inspection plan is provided to allow for the resolution of any scheduling conflicts and personnel availability issues well in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. Additional inspections scheduled include: inspection using procedure 71004 "Power Uprate" to

inspect activities related to the steam dryer replacement on Unit 2, the triennial fire inspection, the biennial PI&R inspection, and the heat sink performance inspection. The inspections in the last nine months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the end-of-cycle review.
