SUBJECT: ANNUAL ASSESSMENT LETTER - JOSEPH M. FARLEY NUCLEAR PLANT REPORT 05000348/2004001 AND 05000364/2004001

Dear Mr. Stinson:

On February 3, 2004, the NRC staff completed its end-of-cycle plant performance assessment of the Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant. The end-of-cycle review for Farley involved the participation of all technical divisions in evaluating performance indicators (PIs) for the most recent quarter and inspection results for the period from January 1 through December 31, 2003. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility so that you will have an opportunity to prepare for these inspections and to inform us of any planned inspections that may conflict with your plant activities.

Overall, Farley operated in a manner that preserved public health and safety and fully met all cornerstone objectives. Plant performance for the most recent quarter, as well as for the first three quarters of the assessment cycle, was within the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all PIs indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green). Therefore, we plan to conduct only reactor oversight process (ROP) baseline inspections at your facility through September 30, 2005. We also plan on conducting several non-ROP inspections which include the reactor pressure vessel head, vessel upper and lower head penetration nozzles, reactor containment sump blockage, spent fuel material control and accounting, license renewal, and independent spent fuel storage installation construction. Additionally, upon finalization of the force-on-force program, we will be conducting an inspection at the next available opportunity to verify the effectiveness of your efforts to address the White finding identified during the previous Operational Security Response Evaluation.

On October 16, 2003, you submitted a request to combine the emergency operating facilities (EOFs) for Farley, Hatch, and Vogtle in to one EOF in Birmingham, Alabama. As part of the review of that request, we made arrangements for a demonstration of the centralized EOF's capabilities on July 14, 2004. This demonstration will include supporting exercises at Plant Farley and Plant Hatch. These exercises are not being evaluated as part of the ROP but will be used to determine approval of the request to combine the EOFs.

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The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections scheduled through September 30, 2005. The inspection plan is provided to minimize the resource impact on your staff and to allow for scheduling conflicts and personnel availability to be resolved in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The inspections in the last twelve months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the mid-cycle review meeting.

As you are aware, the NRC has issued several Orders and threat advisories to enhance security capabilities and improve guard force readiness since the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001. We have conducted inspections to review your implementation of these requirements and have monitored your actions in response to changing threat conditions. For calendar year 2004, we plan to continue inspections of Order implementation combined with newly developed portions of the security baseline inspection program.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html (the Public Electronic Reading Room).
