SUBJECT: MID-CYCLE PERFORMANCE REVIEW AND INSPECTION PLAN -PRAIRIE ISLAND NUCLEAR GENERATING PLANT

Dear Mr. Palmisano:

On August 7, 2006, the NRC staff completed its performance review of the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant for the first half of the calender year 2006 assessment cycle. Our technical staff reviewed the performance indicators (PIs) for the most recent quarter and inspection results over the previous 12 months. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility.

This performance review and enclosed inspection plan do not include physical protection information. A separate letter designated and marked as "Exempt from Public Disclosure in Accordance with 10 CFR 2.390" will include the physical protection review and resultant inspection plan.

Plant performance for the most recent quarter at the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant Units 1 and 2 was within the Licensee Response column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all Pls indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green). Therefore, we plan to conduct reactor oversight process (ROP) baseline inspections at your facility.

The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections, less those related to physical protection, scheduled through March 31, 2008. Significant inspections planned include a "Component Design Basis Inspection" in May 2007, an "Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) Operation Inspection" in June 2007, and a "Modifications/50.59 Inspection" in March 2008. In addition, the resident inspectors plan to perform Temporary Inspections 2515/166, "Pressurized Water Reactor Containment Sump Blockage" on Unit 2 and 2515/169, "Mitigating Systems Performance Index (MSPI) Verification," before the end of calendar year 2006. The inspection plan is provided to allow for the resolution of any scheduling conflicts and personnel availability issues well in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The inspections in the last 9 months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the end-of-cycle review.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <u>http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html</u> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).
