SUBJECT: ANNUAL ASSESSMENT LETTER - RIVER BEND STATION

(NRC INSPECTION REPORT 05000458/2008001)

Dear Mr. Perito:

On February 7, 2008, the NRC staff completed its performance review of the River Bend Station for the calendar year 2007 assessment cycle. Our technical staff reviewed performance indicators for the most recent quarter and inspection results for the period from January 1 through December 31, 2007. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility.

This performance review and enclosed inspection plan do not include security information. A separate letter designated and marked as "Official Use Only--Security Information" will include the security cornerstone review and resultant inspection plan.

Overall, River Bend Station operated in a manner that preserved public health and safety and fully met all cornerstone objectives. Plant performance for the most recent quarter at River Bend Station was within the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all performance indicators indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green).

In our annual assessment letter dated March 2, 2007, a substantive crosscutting issue in the area of human performance associated with instances of ineffective human error techniques within the work practices component was identified. In our midcycle performance assessment letter dated August 31, 2007, the substantive crosscutting issue remained open pending the completion of your effectiveness reviews and our assessment that corrective actions resulted in sustained improved performance. On the basis of the results of your effectiveness reviews, and a sustained reduction in the number of findings, the NRC is closing this substantive crosscutting issue.

Although we noted a theme in the human performance component of work practices, specifically related to the aspect of procedural compliance, recent performance in this area has improved as indicated by only one finding related to procedural compliance since the last assessment. On this basis we have concluded that the scope of your efforts to address this area continues to be effective.

The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections, except those related to physical protection scheduled through June 30, 2009. The inspection plan is provided to allow for the resolution of any scheduling conflicts and personnel availability issues well in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The inspections in the last nine months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the midcycle review.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-m/adams.html (the Public Electronic Reading Room).
