SUBJECT: MID-CYCLE PERFORMANCE REVIEW AND INSPECTION PLAN -SUSQUEHANNA STEAM ELECTRIC STATION UNITS 1 and 2

Dear Mr. Shriver:

On July 31, 2003, the NRC staff completed its mid-cycle plant performance review of the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station Units 1 and 2. The mid-cycle review for Susquehanna involved the participation of all technical divisions in evaluating performance for the first half of the calendar year 2003 assessment cycle. The process included a review of performance indicators (PIs) for the most recent quarter and inspection results over the previous twelve months. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance and our plans for future inspections at your facility so that you will have an opportunity to prepare for these inspections and to inform us of any planned inspections that may conflict with your plant activities.

Plant performance for the most recent quarter was within the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all PIs indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green). Therefore, we plan to conduct only baseline inspections at your facility through September 30, 2004.

In our annual assessment letter dated March 3, 2003, we advised you of a substantive crosscutting issue in the area of human performance because of multiple findings with a common performance deficiency of operators not implementing procedures. Our mid-cycle review has concluded that you have made progress in addressing this cross-cutting issue, but the issue of operators not implementing procedures remains. Improvement in procedure implementation by non-licensed operators and licensed reactor operators has been achieved, however, additional examples of inadequate procedure implementation by senior reactor operators have occurred during the past six months. We will continue to focus on your progress to address this crosscutting issue during our normal baseline inspection program. Mr. Bryce L. Shriver

Additionally, on January 13, 2003 the staff issued a Severity Level III Notice of Violation in accordance with the enforcement policy for a problem that occurred on July 26, 2002, associated with an incorrect gas backfill of a Dry Shielded Canister that was loaded with fuel bundles. Our annual assessment letter dated March 3, 2003, already discussed the staff's acceptance of your corrective actions in this matter.

The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections scheduled through September 30, 2004. Our inspection plan also includes an inspection of your independent spent fuel storage installation in September 2004. The inspection plan is provided to minimize the resource impact on your staff and to allow for scheduling conflicts and personnel availability to be resolved in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The inspections in the last six months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the end-of-cycle review meeting.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html (the Public Electronic Reading Room).
