## SUBJECT: MIDCYCLE PERFORMANCE REVIEW AND INSPECTION PLAN - WATERFORD 3

Dear Mr. Venable:

On August 5, 2003, the NRC staff completed its midcycle plant performance assessment of Waterford 3. The midcycle review for Waterford 3 involved the participation of all technical divisions in evaluating performance indicators (PIs) for the most recent quarter and inspection results for the first half of the current assessment cycle, January 1 through June 30, 2003. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of our assessment of your safety performance during this period and our plans for future inspections at your facility so that you will have an opportunity to prepare for these inspections and to inform us of any planned inspections that may conflict with your plant activities.

Plant performance for the most recent quarter was within the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's Action Matrix, based on all inspection findings being classified as having very low safety significance (Green) and all PIs indicating performance at a level requiring no additional NRC oversight (Green). Therefore, we plan to conduct only baseline inspections and Temporary Instruction 2515/150, "Reactor Pressure Vessel Head and Vessel Head Penetration Nozzles," at your facility through September 30, 2004.

In our annual assessment letter dated March 4, 2003, we advised you of a substantive crosscutting issue in the area of problem identification and resolution. During the current assessment cycle we noted improvements in this area. However, in considering the basis for this substantive crosscutting issue, the NRC noted that a number of the findings resulted from long-standing degraded conditions that were identified by your staff, but the extent of conditions were not fully addressed. Also, a number of problem symptoms were evident for extended periods of time without the causes being identified and corrected. In some cases, the corrective actions associated with these findings involved work performed during refueling outages or work deferred from previous refueling outages. Therefore, we will continue to monitor your efforts to address this substantive crosscutting issue by reviewing the effectiveness of the corrective action process as implemented during the fall 2003 refueling outage. The NRC staff will utilize the baseline inspection program to perform this review.

The enclosed inspection plan details the inspections scheduled through September 30, 2004. The inspection plan is provided to minimize the resource impact on your staff and to allow for

scheduling conflicts and personnel availability to be resolved in advance of inspector arrival onsite. Routine resident inspections are not listed due to their ongoing and continuous nature. The inspections in the last 6 months of the inspection plan are tentative and may be revised at the end-of-cycle review meeting.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
