# China, Peoples Republic of Solid Wood Products China Eliminates Re-Export Preferences 2006

**Report Highlights:** On September 15, China eliminated or decreased re-export preferences for a large category of solid wood products, including veneer and lumber. As a result, Chinese wood manufacturers will now have to pay VAT and duty on some products that are imported and later exported as value-added products, but that were previously without any import or export fees. This change could disrupt some U.S. exports used in products for reexport from China and U.S. companies that have invested in Chinese manufacturing facilities.

# **Executive Summary**

In recent years, China's forest products trade policy has shifted significantly. September 2006 marks further limitations to the products covered under the Chinese "processing trade" (duty-free re-export) program. This means that some imports, previously untaxed, will now have to pay VAT and a duty to be imported, processed, and then re-exported as a finished good. This change continues a trend that lessens the incentives Chinese trade policy offers companies that re-export value-added wood products. Moreover, these changes will impact American and other companies that have invested in Chinese manufacturing facilities that are dependant on the "processing trade" preferences.

This report provides a comprehensive look at the current and former Chinese trade preferences for solid wood products.

# Value-Added Tax (VAT) Export Rebate

China has long had a number of value-added manufacturing industries that it has wanted to support. One of these industries was the wood processing industry. The creation of raw material import preferences has been one way to promote the creation of processing industries within China.

One of the programs is the VAT Export Rebate program. Under this program, Chinese companies that exported products qualified for a VAT rebate. There were no restrictions in terms of raw materials (domestic sourced or imported) on products that were covered. The company received a partial refund of the previously paid VAT amount, calculated at a set rate, after the products were exported. The VAT rebate rate for wood products differs from 5 percent (particle board) to 11 percent (plywood and wooden furniture). Please see Appendix 2 for the complete tariff schedule of wood products.

A large category of wood products, including logs, lumber, veneer, and solid wood flooring (laminated wood flooring is still eligible for a VAT rebate), have not been eligible for the VAT rebate since January 1, 2004. Table 1 describes the tariff codes that have been eliminated from the VAT rebate program.

Effective September 15, 2006, the VAT rebates on wood-based panels, wooden furniture, and various other products were reduced to 11 percent from 13 percent. Table 2 contains a detailed H.S. code and product description list for products that experienced a VAT rebate reduction.

#### **Processing Trade Preferences**

In recent years, the other main trade preference program for the wood processing industry has been the "processing trade" tariff preference. Products under this category can be imported duty and VAT free if they are subsequently re-exported as a value-added product.

However, the processing trade category has been slowly phased out in a fashion similar to that of the VAT rebate program. Table 1 shows the timeline and products eliminated from the processing trade category. Beginning September 15, 2006, many important wood product tariff codes no longer qualify for the "processing trade" preference. According to the official announcement by Ministry of Finance and other four ministries dated September 14, 2006, all commodities for which export rebates have been eliminated would be included in the "Category of Commodities Banned from the Processing Trade". The same document stated "Detailed names and tariff codes of commodities in the Category will be published by the MOFCOM and relevant authenticities later". Though the final Category is not available at

this moment, Table 1 has been developed by Post according to the guideline of the Announcement. Table 1 contains unofficial data. The Chinese Government will publish the official list of tariff codes at a later date. The original Chinese document is available at:

According to the new policy, wood-based panels (H.S. code 4410, 4411, and 4412), wooden door and windows (H.S. code 4418), other articles of wood (H.S. code 4421), and wooden furniture (9403) remain in the processing trade category. According to Post's statistics, the top eight export wood product categories (by four-digit H.S. code) account for about 90 percent of China's total wooden products (H.S. code 44) exports in value. Only tongued, grooved wood products (H.S. code 4409, accounting for nine percent of total wood exports) and disposable wooden chopsticks (H.S. code 44190010, accounting for two percent of total wood exports) have been eliminated from the processing trade category. Therefore, the major exporting wood products remain in processing trade program.

In 2005, exports of wooden products to the United States within the H.S. codes 4412, 4421,4418,4420,4414,4411,4419 (not including 44190010), and 4415 accounted for 88 percent of China's total wood product (H.S. code 44) exports to the United States. All of the above-mentioned H.S. codes remain in the processing trade program. This dynamic is important because a significant portion of China's wood products exported to the United States use U.S. wood as a raw material. Given that fact, Post believes that the impact to the U.S. wood exports to China is limited.

As mentioned above, single veneer (H.S. Code 4408) and solid wood flooring (H.S. code 4409) have been eliminated from the processing trade. For these products, the new policy is a significant change. For example, when veneer was imported using the processing trade program, a Chinese company could import U.S. logs or lumber and re-export veneer made from it without duty or VAT. Given the changes in the law, the company would now pay 13 percent VAT (for logs) or 17 percent VAT (for lumber) upon import, plus 17 percent VAT on the value-added finished export. (Though, according to China's VAT policy, VAT paid for an imported input product is deducted from the exported finished product VAT.) For example, under the new policy, a Chinese veneer processor imports U.S. lumber valued at US \$1,000. The company would pay a US \$170 VAT. After processing the lumber into veneer, the exported veneer is valued at US \$1,500. The processor owes US \$255 total VAT. However, he only needs to pay US \$85 (255-170) for the export VAT because the import VAT can be deducted from total VAT amount. Under the old policy, the processor would not have paid any VAT.

China's new policy indicates that China is beginning to take measures to change the current exporting structure and it may reduce the advantages that some companies rely upon to sell to the export market (including wood products, furniture and plywood). The clear, but gradual, shift in China's policy favors companies that focus on China's domestic market. Companies that rely on re-exporting must focus on productivity gains to maintain competitiveness.

#### **Government Considers Tariff Hikes**

Chinese industry has recently expressed concern about Government possible changes to import tariffs. Specifically, industry has suggested that increases in tariffs for veneers would not be welcome. As noted above, experts speculate that the Chinese Government considers

the industry too dependent on re-export of furniture and other products and that changes to the tariff structure (in addition to the partial elimination of the processing trade category) may force the industry to sell more domestically. In addition to the excellent trade ties Chinese exporters have with customers, industry leaders suggest that restrictions log exporters are placing on exports of round wood could backfire and higher tariffs would create unacceptably high log and veneer prices.

# **Reference Prices Under the Microscope**

One additional issue that U.S. and other exporters have been concerned about is the method for calculating reference prices for imported wood products. Many believe that the Chinese minimum reference price for calculating the duty and VAT for many wood products does not reflect the true value of the wood. Specifically, the minimum reference price is set too high for many categories and is greater than the value of the wood. Therefore, the resultant duty is higher than it would be using the true value of the shipment. Industry source indicate that local customs develop their own reference prices independently, which means different customs posts have different reference price.

#### **Appendix 1: MOFCOM Processing Trade Regulation**

Notice of the Ministry of Finance and Four Other Ministries/Administrations concerning the Adjustment of Export Tax Rebates for Some Commodities and the Enlargement of the Catalogue of Banned Commodities in Processing Trade

Issued by: MOF, NDRC, MOFCOM, the General Administration of Customs (Customs), the

State Administration of Taxation (SAT) Document code: Caishui [2006] 139 Issued on: September 14, 2006 Effective Date: September 15, 2006

To the Departments/Bureaus of Finance in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government and cities specifically designated in the State plan<sup>1</sup>, SAT, the NDRC, commercial authorities, Guangdong Branch of General Administration of Customs<sup>2</sup>, Financial Bureau and Development & Reform Committee of the Xinjiang Production and Construction Corps of CPLA<sup>3</sup>:

Approved by the State Council, we adjusted the export tax rebate for some commodities and expanded the Catalogue of Banned Commodities in Processing Trade. It is hereby announced:

### Adjust the export tax rebate for some commodities:

# Export tax rebate for the following commodities are removed:

All non-metal mineral products except salt and cement in Section 25 of the Customs Import and Export Tariff; coal, natural gas, paraffin wax, bitumen, silicon, arsenic, stone, non-ferrous metal and wastes and scraps.

Cermets<sup>4</sup>, 25 types of chemical pesticides and intermediates, some leather products, lead-acid accumulators, mercuric-oxide cell.

Fine hair of goats, wood charcoal, railway sleepers, cork products, some primary wood products, etc.

# Lower export tax rebate for the following commodities:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Cities specifically designated in the State plan refer to economically significant cities whose economic planning are independent of the provincial government and receive some direction from the Central Government. Currently there are five such cities in China – Qingdao, Shenzhen, Xiamen, Ningbo and Dalian.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> China Customs exercises a vertical and three-tiered management structure. The top tier is the General Administration of Customs; the middle tier is composed of the Guangdong Sub-Administration of Customs (in charge of 7 Customs regions located in Guangdong Province), two Supervising Offices in Tianjin and Shanghai, 41 Customs regions and two Customs educational institutions; the third tier refers to the 562 Customs houses or offices under those 41 Customs regions.

Reduce the export tax rebates for steel products (under 142 tariff codes) from 11% to 8%:

Reduce the export tax rebates for ceramic products, some leather products, cement and glass from 13% to 8% or 11%;

Reduce the export tax rebates for some non-ferrous metal from 13% to 5%, 8% and 11%:

Reduce the export tax rebates for textile products, furniture, plastic, lighter, and some wood products from 13% to 11%;

Reduce the export tax rebates for non-mechanically propelled vehicles (trolley) and their parts from 17% to 13%;

Please refer to the Appendix II for commodities and their tariff codes.

#### Increase export tariff of the following commodities:

Increase the export tax rebates for key technology and equipment, some IT products, bio-pharmaceutical products, and some high-tech products encouraged by the State's industrial policies from 13% to 17%;

Increase the export tax rebates for some products processed from agricultural materials from 5% or 11% to 13%.

# Time of implementation

The adjustment of export tariff rebates will be implemented on September 15, 2006 (as of the date of declaration for export);

If contracts for exporting commodities subject to the adjustment were signed on or before September 14, 2006 and the commodities were declared for export at the Customs on or before December 14, 2006, the exporting enterprises can choose to be governed by the export tax rebate rates before the adjustment. To do so, the exporting enterprise must register the contract at the export tariff rebate authorities before September 30, 2006; those fail to register the contract or declared commodities for exports on or after December 15, 2006, are subject to the export tax rebate rates after the adjustment.

The aforementioned export contract refers to export contracts in writing that comply with the "Contract Law" and relevant laws/regulations. The contract must be valid and clearly indicate date of signature of the contract, name of the commodities, unit price, quantity and value of the transaction. The contract must be confirmed by the exporting enterprise and the foreign customer with signatures or seals. The export tariff rebate authorities will not register export contracts that fail to meet these requirements. Once registered, the contract should not be amended. The State Administration of Taxation will issue separate regulations governing the registration of the export contract.

Upon discovery of enterprises' changing, faking or retroactively signing the contract, the taxation administration authority will not grant tax rebate to the enterprise; the already rebated tax or rebate exceeding the due amount should be recovered, and the exporting enterprise is subject to punishment in accordance with relevant laws and regulations.

For long-term contracts of coal exports signed on or before September 14, 2006, the exporting enterprise should register the contracts at the export tax rebate authorities before September 30, 2006. The registered export contracts are subject to the export tax rebate rates before the adjustment.

The aforementioned customs declaration time is as of the export date indicated on the "Goods Declaration for Exportation [for Export Tax Rebate]".

# **Expand the Catalogue of Banned Commodities in Processing Trade**

Commodities for which export tax rebates have been cancelled previously and this time will be included in the Catalogue of Banned Commodities in Processing Trade, which are subject to the import tariff and the import linkage tax<sup>56</sup>. Detailed names and tariff codes of commodities in the Catalogue will be published by the MOFCOM and relevant authenticities.

These Regulations will be effective September 15, 2006. Processing trade contracts approved by the commercial authorities and registered at Customs before the adjustment can be implemented according to the original import bonds policies until their contract term closes. If the processing enterprise fails to export the commodity by the end of contract schedule, it is not allowed to extend the contract, and is subject to tax as domestic sales of processing trade. The MOFCOM will work with the Customs General Administration and issue a separate Notice in this regard.

These Regulations are applicable to special areas supervised by Customs, including export processing zones and bonded zones.
