We wrote to you on March 16, 2007, indicating that we would need additional time to complete our response to your January 15, 2007, request for reconsideration submitted pursuant to the Federal Data Quality Act, HHS Information Quality Guidelines, and the FDA Guidelines for Ensuring the Quality of Information Disseminated to the Public. These guidelines state that it is FDA's goal to respond to each request for reconsideration within 60 days of receipt either by providing a decision on the request or, if the request will require more time to complete, informing the complainant of the status of the request.

At this time we are continuing to prepare our response and require additional time to coordinate Agency review. We anticipate that a response will be forwarded to you within 60 days.
