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Challenges

- Usefulness Content and Format Issues
- Awareness
- Practitioner and Patient Access
- Poor Document Quality Technical Issues
- Rapid Growth of the Medication Guide Program
- Cost / Inefficiency

Improve Usefulness

- Clearly define and standardize scope of content
 - Balance risk and benefit information
 - Refer to CMI
 - Limit length
- Clearly define and standardize format
 - Action Plan criteria ??

Improve Awareness and Access

- Specific alert mechanism re: availability of new or revised Medication Guides
- Maintain <u>UP-TO-DATE</u> repository for <u>ALL</u> current Medication Guides
 - CDER website / DailyMed
- Promote multiple avenues of distribution
 - Physician / Pharmacy
 - Paper / Electronic
 - Patient Access via Internet

Technical Issues

- Final Medication Guide approved by FDA should be a separate document from product labeling and available in electronic form.
- Allowance for format alternatives when necessary to facilitate electronic distribution to pharmacies and pharmacy software vendors

Rapid Growth

- Define specific criteria for Medication Guide eligibility
- Utilize class Medication Guides as appropriate
- Avoid proprietary information (eg, brand names) within the Medication Guide.
