## Active ingredient (in each tablet) Purpose

Omeprazole magnesium delayed-release tablet 20.6 mg (equivalent to 20 mg omeprazole).....

- treats frequent heartburn (occurs <u>2 or more</u> days a week)
   not intended for immediate relief of heartburn; this drug may take 1 to 4 days for full effect

Allergy alert: Do not use if you are allergic to omeprazole

**Do not use** if you have trouble or pain swallowing food, vomiting with blood, or bloody or black stools.

These may be signs of a serious condition. See your doctor

- Ask a doctor before use if you have

  had heartburn over 3 months. This may be a sign of a more serious
- condition.
   hearburn with lightheadedness, sweating or dizziness
   chest pain or shoulder pain with shortness of breath; sweating; pain spreading to arms, neck or shoulders; or lightheadedness
- frequent chest pain frequent wheezing, particularly with heartburn
- unexplained weight loss unausea or vomiting stomach pain

# Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are taking warfarin (blood-thinning medicine) prescription antifungal or anti-yeast medicines diazepam (anxiety medicine)

- digoxin (heart medicine)
   tacrolimus (immune system medicine)
   atazanavir (medicine for HIV Infection)

## Drug Facts (continued)

- Stop use and ask a doctor if

  your heartburn continues or worsens
- you need to take this product for more than 14 days
- you need to take more than 1 course of treatment every 4 months

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional

Keep out of reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

## Directions

- adults 18 years of age and older
   this product is to be used once a day (every 24 hours), every day for
- it may take 1 to 4 days for full effect, although some people get complete relief of symptoms within 24 hours

### 14-Day Course of Treatment

- swallow 1 tablet with a glass of water before eating in the morning take every day for 14 days

- do not take more than I tablet a day do not chew or crush the tablets
- do not crush tablets in food
- do not use for more than 14 days unless directed by your doctor

## Repeated 14-Day Courses (if needed)

- you may repeat a 14-day course every 4 months
   do not take for more than 14 days or more often than every 4 months unless directed by a doctor
- children under 18 years of age: ask a doctor
