NSIR Mission

- To prevent nuclear security incidents and prepare for and respond to safety and security events.
- Prior to Sept 11, 2001, Headquarters security functions were divided between NRR & NMSS
- NSIR was established April 2002
- Today, NSIR functions with 3 Technical Divisions
 - Incident Response & Emergency Planning
 - Security Operations
 - Security Policy

Federal Coordination

- Routine coordination with a range of Federal partners, such as DHS, HSC, FBI, DOD, DOE, USCG, and the intelligence community.
- NSIR staff embedded in NCTC, DHS/DNDO, DHS/IP.
