DAVIS-BACON AND RELATED ACIS: INSCENTRALIZATION OF PROJECT

WAGE DETERMINATIONS TO REGIONAL ADMINISTRATORS, EN PLOYMENT

STANDARDS ADMINISTRATION

This is to notify you that project wage determiniations under Davis-Bacon will not be decentralized on January 3, 1972 as indicated in our All Agency Memorandum #102. It has been necessary for a infinitetrative reasons to delay the effective date of decentralization of project wage determinations. This will give the contracting agencies additional time to prepare for the decentralization.

As soon as a new effective date for decentralization is established, you will be edvised promptly. Until a new effective date is established, requests for wage determinations (IB-11's) should be sent to the National Office of the Employment Standards Administration as in the past. However, where arrangements have already been made to furnish requests to the Regions, such arrangements may be followed at the contracting agency's discretion and Regions will immediately forward such requests to this office. In the meant line, contincting agencies should feel free to make contacts with our Regions and use the services of the Wage Specialists in each of the Regional Offices.
