

**SUBJECT: Department of Energy (DOE) Fiscal Year (FY) 2008 and FY 2009  
Small Business Prime Contracting and Subcontracting Goals**

On January 29, 2008 the Office of Procurement and Assistance Management (OPAM) issued the FY 2008 and FY 2009 Small Business Subcontracting Goals under Policy Flash 2008-18. Those goals remain unchanged. Yesterday, OPAM received the Department's final goals for Prime Contracting as set forth by the Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization (OSDBU). DOE now has the following small business Prime Contracting goals for FYs 2008 and 2009:

Small Business concerns	5.87%
8(a)	1.03%
Other Small Disadvantaged Business (SDB) concerns	0.54%
Women-Owned Small Business concerns	0.71%
HUB-Zone Small Business concerns	0.20%
Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business concerns	0.70%
