
SUBJECT: DOE O 221.1A – Reporting Fraud, Waste and Abuse to the Office of Inspector General

SUMMARY: The Department issued Contractor Requirements Document (CRD) on April 19, 2008 to the above listed Directive.

Under the Department's Directives Program (DOE Order 251.1B), Heads of Field Elements are responsible for determining which contracts are to include this CRD. Contracting Officers, once notified, are responsible for incorporating the CRD into affected contracts. Since some Heads of Field Elements may not be aware that this change has been issued, Contracting Officers should request their determination of which, if any, contracts are affected and remind them that they may sign up for automated notification at www.directives.doe.gov.
