Dear Mr. Zukoski:

The Office for Human Research Protections (OHRP) has reviewed the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign's (UIUC) August 5, 2005 report submitted in response to OHRP's letter of June 30, 2005. In addition, OHRP has reviewed a report from Dr. Robert Palinkas, Director, McKinley Health Clinic (MHC), dated August 5, 2005.

After reviewing these reports, OHRP finds no compelling reason to alter its previous determinations. OHRP remains particularly concerned that research activities may continue to be conducted at the MHC under the guise of quality improvement programs. UIUC has indicated that a number of these programs now have current IRB approval and has initiated corrective actions to address OHRP's previous determinations. These corrective actions include:

(i) Audits of the MHC will be conducted annually for the next three years; (ii) the Director of the IRB office will serve as a member of the MHC Research and Grants Compliance Committee; and (iii) all staff at the MHC will be required to attend human subjects research training at least annually. OHRP finds that the corrective actions described in UIUC's May 25, 2005 report adequately address the determinations made in OHRP's March 14, 2005 letter and are appropriate under the UIUC FWA. Furthermore, OHRP finds that UIUC has adequately addressed the additional questions and concerns raised in OHRP's March 14, 2005 letter.

As a result of these determinations, there should be no need for further involvement of OHRP in this matter. However, please note that OHRP plans to conduct an on-site evaluation of UIUC's system for the protection of human subjects in the next 12 - 24 months.
