**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE**

**OFFERED BY MR. PALLONE**

**(Ryan White HIV/AIDS Treatment Modernization Act of 2006)**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. ONE-YEAR EXTENSION.**

2 (a) AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR FIS-  
3 CAL YEAR 2007.—Notwithstanding any provision of title  
4 XXVI of the Public Health Service Act:

5 (1) For the purpose of carrying out part A of  
6 such title, there is authorized to be appropriated  
7 \$634,209,704 for fiscal year 2007.

8 (2) For the purpose of carrying out part B of  
9 such title, there is authorized to be appropriated  
10 \$1,195,500,000 for fiscal year 2007.

11 (3) For the purpose of grants to States that  
12 demonstrate unmet needs with respect to HIV/AIDS  
13 and that do not have any areas that receive grants  
14 under part A of such title for fiscal year 2007, there  
15 is authorized to be appropriated \$30,000,000 for fis-  
16 cal year 2007.

1           (4) For the purpose of carrying out part C of  
2 such title, there is authorized to be appropriated  
3 \$218,600,000 for fiscal year 2007.

4           (5) For the purpose of carrying out part D of  
5 such title, there is authorized to be appropriated  
6 \$75,385,648 for fiscal year 2007.

7           (6) For purposes of AIDS Education and  
8 Training Centers under section 2692 of part F of  
9 such title, there is authorized to be appropriated  
10 \$35,983,900 for fiscal year 2007.

11           (7) For purposes of dental programs under sec-  
12 tion 2692 of part F of such title, there is authorized  
13 to be appropriated \$13,570,182 for fiscal year 2007.  
14 Amounts appropriated under this subsection are available  
15 to the Secretary until the end of fiscal year 2009.

16           (b) NAMES-BASED REPORTING OF CASES; OTHER  
17 CHANGES REGARDING METHODOLOGY FOR COUNTING  
18 CASES.—Notwithstanding any provision of title XXVI of  
19 the Public Health Service Act, the Secretary may not, in  
20 determining the amounts of formula grants under such  
21 title for fiscal year 2007, use a methodology for counting  
22 the number of cases of acquired immune deficiency syn-  
23 drome, or the number of cases of HIV, that is different  
24 than the methodology used by the Secretary for such pur-  
25 poses for fiscal year 2006.

1           (c) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this section, the  
2 terms “HIV” and “Secretary” have the meanings that  
3 apply to such terms under title XXVI of the Public Health  
4 Service Act.
