RULE 302. FEES FOR PUBLICATION

- (a) The Executive Officer shall designate those publications, including information circulars, reports of technical work, or other reports, prepared by the District for which a fee shall be charged. After such a publication has been designated by the Executive Officer, any person receiving such publication shall pay a fee. Such fee shall be established by the Executive Officer in a sum not to exceed the cost of preparation and distribution of such documents. Such fees shall be deposited in the general funds of the District.
- (b) Cities and counties shall be entitled to receive one copy of any District publication without charge.
- (c) Nothing in this Rule shall be construed to limit the rights of any person, or of the District, pursuant to the California Public Records Act, Chapter 3.5, Division 7 of Title 1 (commencing with Section 6250) of the Government Code.
