Project Funding Criteria

- Agricultural engines >50 hp required to comply with SCAQMD Rule 1110.2 by January 1, 2010
- Stationary non-emergency engines permanently installed in one location or portable engine that operates in one location for the full season of a seasonal operation
- Replacement of an engine with an electric motor or new engine with Rule 1110.2 – compliant emission controls
- Funding up to 85% of replacement cost
- Projects must be operational prior to January 1, 2010
- Qualifying projects will be funded on a first-come-first-served basis until May 29, 2009
