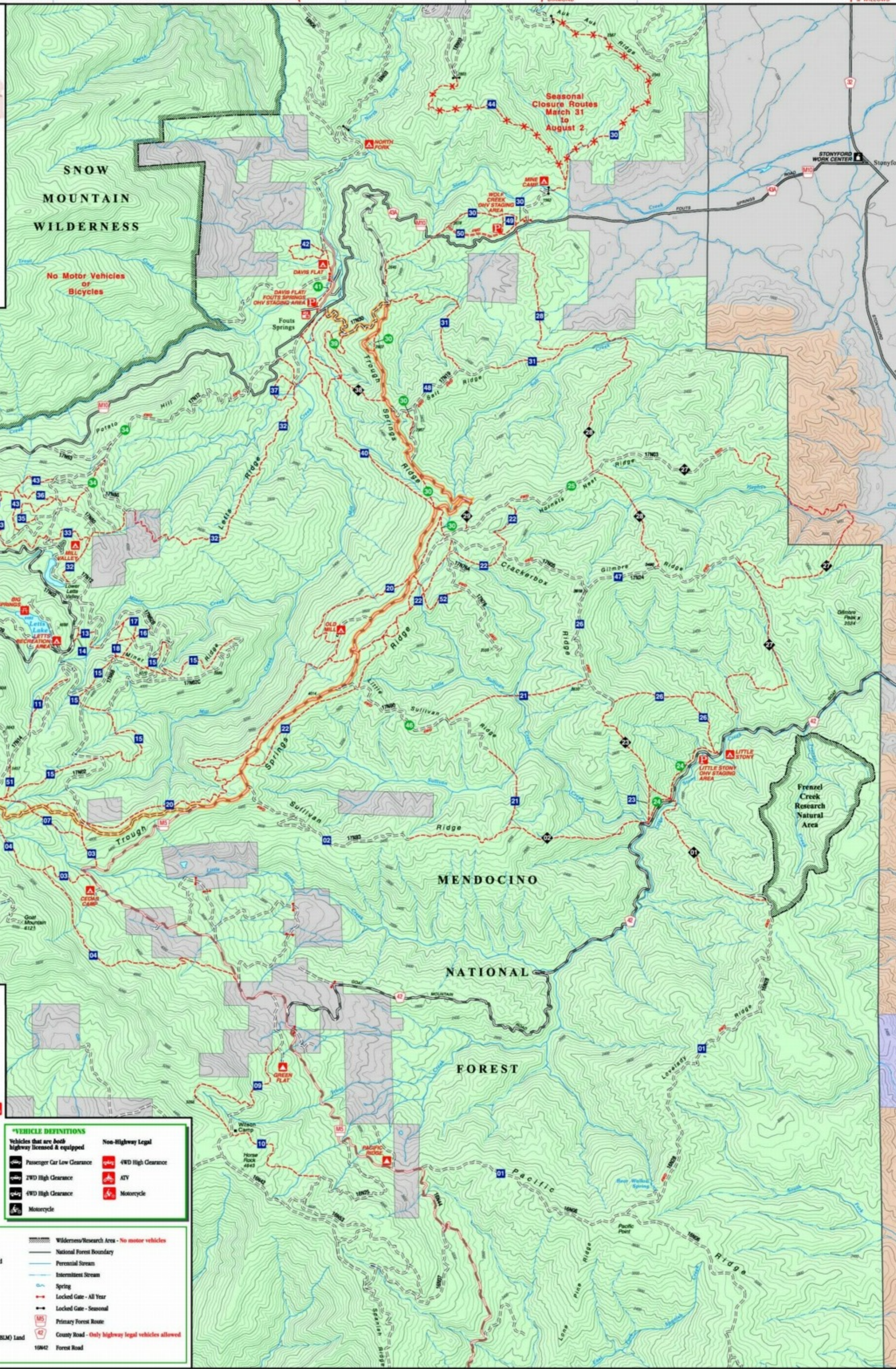
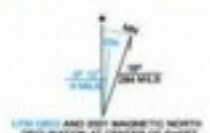

Improved Dirt Road: Only for vehicles that are Auto highway licensed & equipped	

OHV Routes	RECOMMENDED VEHICLES*
Combined Use Road: Highway licensed & OHV	
Unimproved Road: Not recommended for passenger cars, non-highway legal OHVs permitted (unless signed otherwise)	
Unimproved Road: High clearance, 4WD vehicles recommended, non-highway legal OHVs permitted (unless signed otherwise)	
OHV Trail: High clearance vehicles, ATVs and motorcycles	
OHV Trail: ATVs and motorcycles (unless signed otherwise)	
OHV Trail: Seasonal Closure: March 31 to August 2
