SBA Disaster Loan Outreach Center in Lexington to Close

SACRAMENTO – Leon Milobar, Director of the U.S. Small Business Administration’s (SBA) Nebraska District Office, announced today that SBA’s Disaster Loan Outreach Center in **Lexington** will close on **Thursday, August 28 at 6 pm**. “So far, SBA has approved \$3.1 million in disaster loans to Nebraska residents and businesses hurt by the May 22 through June 24 severe storms, tornadoes and flooding,” said Milobar.

“SBA customer service representatives continue to be available at the Disaster Loan Outreach Center to answer questions about SBA’s disaster loan program, explain the application process, help individuals complete their applications and close approved disaster loans,” he added.

Residents and business owners who suffered damages as a result of the May 22 through June 24 severe storms, tornadoes and flooding can speak with SBA representatives on the days and times indicated below until the office closes. No appointment is necessary.
