## SBA to Close Brownsville Disaster Loan Outreach Center

**Sacramento, CA** – Kim Jones, Director of the U. S. Small Business Administration's Lower Rio Grande Valley District Office, announced today that SBA will close its Brownsville Disaster Loan Outreach Center (DLOC) at the close of business on **Friday, October 31, 2008.** The center, located at the Brownsville Chamber of Commerce at 1600 University Boulevard, is open from 8 am to 5 pm daily. "Until then, SBA will continue to provide one-on-one service to disaster victims of Hurricane Dolly," she said.

SBA customer service representatives also will continue to be available at the Lower Rio Grande District Office DLOC to answer questions about SBA's disaster loan program and close their approved disaster loans." "Individuals and businesses can meet with SBA representatives on the days and times indicated. No appointment is necessary," Jones continued.
