Arrests, Metropolitan Counties, by Age, 2007

- In 2007, most individuals (87.9 percent) who were arrested in metropolitan counties were age 18 and over.
- Nearly 28 percent (27.8) of those arrested in metropolitan counties in 2007 were between the ages of 18 and 24.
- Fourteen percent of arrestees for violent crimes in metropolitan counties were juveniles (those under age 18). Juveniles also accounted for 23.5 percent of arrestees for property crimes in metropolitan counties.
- Arrests for driving under the influence accounted for 13.6 percent of all arrests in metropolitan counties in 2007. Drug abuse violations accounted for 12.6 percent of arrests.
