## Arrests, Suburban Areas, by Sex, 2007

- More than three-fourths (75.7 percent) of the 4,202,876 persons arrested in the Nation's suburban areas in 2007 were male.
- In 2007, males accounted for 82.1 percent of all those arrested for violent crime and 66.7 percent of the people arrested for property crime.
- Drug abuse violations (396,508) and driving under the influence (391,258) were the offenses for which males were most frequently arrested.
- Females were most often arrested for larceny-theft offenses (135,035) and driving under the influence (105,082).
