Entergy Nuclear Indian Point 2, LLC and Entergy Nuclear Indian Point 3, LLC (hereafter referred to as "Entergy"), the owner of Indian Point Units 2 and 3 (Indian Point) is in the process of completing an application to be filed with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a potential 20 year renewal of Indian Point's operating licenses. Enercon is gathering information on Entergy's behalf relative to this potential license renewal.

Indian Point is located on the eastern bank of the Hudson River at Indian Point in the Village of Buchanan in upper Westchester County, New York. The exact location of the site is latitude 41°16'11" and longitude 73°57'8". The entire site is owned by Entergy and contains approximately 239 acres, bounded on the north, south, and east by privately owned land and on the west by the Hudson River.

The NRC requires that Entergy's application for license renewal at Indian Point, "assess the impact of the proposed action." In an effort to ascertain any potential concerns that could arise as a result of license renewal at Indian Point, Enercon is requesting any information you may have regarding potential impacts to archaeological or historic resources in the vicinity of the Station (see attached maps, photographs, and Project Review Cover Form).

In the event of license renewal at Indian Point, it is not anticipated there would be any alterations to current plant operations and maintenance activities would be limited to previously disturbed areas on site and all such activities are overseen via company procedures which regulate all such activities relative to cultural resources and land disturbances, in addition to applicable state and federal laws. License renewal at Indian Point would not require the expansion of existing facilities or additional land disturbances.

Location of Indian Point Units 2 and 3





Figure 2-2
General Area Near IP2 and IP3


