Antelope Lake Recreation Area Open

Paved roads from Janesville and Genesee Valley entering the Antelope Lake Recreation Area have re-opened. The temporary road closures were implemented for public safety during the Moonlight Fire. Forest closures of the Antelope Fire Complex and Moonlight Fire areas including most dirt roads remain in effect for safety until further notice.
