Temporary Burn Ban Lifted

The temporary residential burn ban has been lifted by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL-FIRE), effective October 29. If residents obtain their burn permit from the Plumas National Forest, this applies. The burn ban was imposed due to fire weather conditions last week and the drawdown of firefighting resources assigned to southern California fires.

Residents are reminded to contact the nearest Air Quality Control office to determine if it is a burn day.
