# **CASES CLOSED JUNE 2001**

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges. This publication is distributed monthly on a subscription basis by the Government Printing Office. During FY 2001, the NLRB continued to improve its techniques for tracking and collecting case activity data.
